#### **CIL EXPENDITURE**

During the year a seat was installed in the centre of Totton in recognition of Aaron Phipps M.B.E. with space to accommodate wheelchair users, costing was £3,161.91. Defibrillators were installed on the outside of the Civic Centre, West Totton Centre and ML Carpet shop at a cost of £4,549.64. An exterior public notice board was supplied and fitted near the Civic Centre costing £1,229.90 and signage installed at Eling Tide Mill costing £1,410.00.
